



Ribbonwinners Tatting Patterns & Shuttles by
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Nina Libin - Beaded Necklace (Needle Tatting)

The Online Tatting Class welcomes Nina Libin. Nina shares her design for a beaded necklace with directions for both shuttle and needle tatting. Many thanks.

Two color necklace - bnl016

(For needle tatting)

You will need 12 -13 yards of
DMC # 20 thread,
424 (430) light color seed beads
9 and
157 (160) blue Iris three-cut # 9.

Symbols used through the
pattern:

° = white seed bead

· = blue Iris 3-cuts

// = shape, tighten & turn upside
down

^ = lock join to the previous
chain

~ = reverse the work

Take a ball of thread and
'needle' the tail;

String: $[12^\circ + 4 \cdot + 12^\circ + 5 \cdot]$ 17
times + $[12^\circ + 4 \cdot + 4^\circ]$ once.



This is enough beads for a 18" necklace;
thread the needle; be sure that there are 4 light seeds on the loop and make the only ring in the pattern. After that there are all chains.



1. R: 1°1°1°1 - 1°1//
2. CH: 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 - 1°1//^~
3. CH: 1°1°1°1°1°1 - 1°1//^~
4. CH: 1°1°1°1°1 - 1°1//^~

5. CH: 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 - 1°1//^~
6. CH: 1°1°1°1°1 - 1°1//^~
7. CH: 1°1°1°1°1°1 - 1°1//^~ For a 16 - 18" necklace,
8. CH: 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 · 1 - 1°1//^~ repeat positions 5 through 10
9. CH: 1°1°1°1°1°1 - 1°1//^~ 15 -17 times
10. CH: 1°1°1°1°1 - 1°1//^~
