

Tat-ra-Sutra


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Here is a little butterfly that I tatted with one shuttle, and size 5 DMC Pearl Cotton in a rich dark blue. I made the pattern up as I went along, using up the thread at the end of the shuttle.



1 Shuttle
Make the wing Picots in graduated sizes

- Upper Wing:
R
6-2-2-2-2-5-3.
Close, do not RW
- Lower Wing:
R 3+3-2-2-6.
Close, do not RW
- Lower Wing:
R 6-2-2-3-3.
Close, do not RW
- Upper Wing:
R
3+5-2-2-2-2-6.
Close, do not RW
- Head: R 10
Jos Knot, Large Picot, 10 Jos Knots. Close, cut large picot into antennae
- Weave thread ends through

towards rump,
for wing tails.
Cut even.

R=Ring - =
picot RW=
Reverse work
Jos
Knot=Josephine
Knots, or *only
the first half* of
the double
stitch.



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
