SMALL CROSS - © Jane Eborall



This cross could be used for earrings if the top bead is omitted and the finished piece added to an ear wire.

Materials:

1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards no. 20 thread. 4 beads. 1 shuttle and 1 mini shuttle

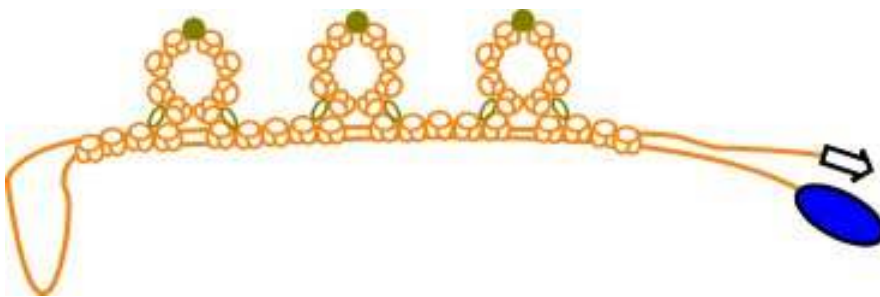
Abbreviations:

vsp very small
picot SCMR self closing mock ring + join

Mini shuttle – homemade from a piece of plastic

Wind thread onto a shuttle, add 3 beads (and leave on Wsh2), tie to the mini shuttle. Using the mini shuttle (Wsh1) make a chain after looping it round the smallest finger and starting 6" from the mini shuttle (SCMR). All chains are made with Wsh1 and rings with Wsh2. The arrow in fig. 1 represents the Wsh1.

Ch: 3 – 1
R1: 1 + (p on Ch) 3 B 3 – 1
Ch: 1 + (p on R1) 3 – 1
R2: 1 + (p on Ch) 3 B 3 – 1
Ch: 1 + (p on R2) 3 – 1
R3: 1 + (p on Ch) 3 B 3 – 1
Ch: 1 + (p on R3) 3



Take Wsh1 through the loop made round the small finger and close the SCMR

Using Wsh2 for the first part and Wsh1 for second part – make



SR

SR4: 6 / 6

SR5: 6 / 6 Cut both threads leaving enough to add a bead and tie a knot. Trim.
